Schools Outreach Work

At Prestwick Tennis & Fitness, we are passionate about bringing sport into schools and ensuring every child has the chance to play. Working in partnership with South Ayrshire Active Schools, we deliver an extensive outreach programme offering incurriculum tennis sessions at minimal cost to local primary schools. Pupils from Kingcase Primary attend weekly sessions at our Prestwick centre, with all **400 pupils participating throughout the year**. A similar partnership with Heathfield Primary enables around 600 pupils to experience tennis as part of their school timetable, and plans are in place to expand this initiative to Glenburn and St Ninian's Primaries in early 2026. In addition, the club regularly hosts tennis and badminton competitions for Ayrshire schools in collaboration with the Local Authority's Active Schools teams, helping young people enjoy friendly competition and develop new skills.

Disability Programme

Under our disability tennis programme, PT&F currently disability classes for both LD and Wheelchair players (adult and juniors). We also currently have 2 visually impaired members who play this version of tennis to a competitive standard.

Prestwick regularly hosts disability tennis tournaments organised through the West of Scotland Disability Tennis programme.

We also offer a weekly in curriculum tennis class for pupils attending Southcraig School which caters for children and young people with complex needs. These sessions provide a great opportunity for circa 30 pupils to participate in sport in a safe and welcoming environment.



The Vision..

- Prestwick Tennis & Fitness: a not-for-profit organisation at the heart of the community.
- Mission: "Accessible, family-friendly sport and fitness opportunities for all."
- Next step: introducing Padel, one of the fastest growing sports in the UK and Europe, to South Ayrshire.

Why Padel?

The introduction of this new sport will complement our existing racket sports offering. It is our intention to introduce Padel tennis classes at an affordable price to both adults and junior players.

Local schools will be offered regular opportunities for pupils to come and try this new sport.

We will also incorporate Padel classes into our LD/Disability programme.

In terms of inclusion and inter-generational activities, Padel tennis is open to all. It can be played by mixed sex and mixed age groups and enjoyed by everybody. It contributes to a healthy lifestyle and is very sociable being played as doubles. The padel courts will be available for the community to use as well as members.
